Overnight care between 10pm and 7am

If you have a patient with a terminal illness who would benefit from overnight nursing care, you can refer them to us.

Referral criteria:

- Registered to a GP in the Vale of York
- 18+ years old
- Have identified palliative care needs
- Wish to remain at home
- Have a GP willing to care for them at home
- Have family or carers who need additional support

Referrals can be made by a District Nurse or Community Palliative Care Clinical Nurse Specialist, following discussion with the District Nurse.

- **Urgent – prognosis of hours to days; same day or next day care is needed**
- **Changing needs – unstable symptoms; a high level of nursing care is needed**
- **Stable needs – prognosis of weeks to months**
