Some of the recommendations will have a financial impact on the primary care prescribing budget – this impact is indicated for each individual drug on the attached recommendations – please see below for attached.

Please note an error related to the savings estimated for the Sirdupla[®] - this change only affects one strength of inhaler and only for asthma patients (the saving quoted in the attached paper was for all strengths and for both asthma and COPD), therefore the new savings at a 65% switch rate are estimated at ~£160,000. Primary care will be supported to achieve these savings by the medicines management team and Optimise Rx software.
